

1 STEVE AND JANICE QUAKENBUSH are committed to providing academic resources and training for Wycliffe Bible Translators in the U.S., so that people of all nations can have access to the Scriptures in a language that speaks to their hearts.

2 CENTRAL UNION MISSION is one of America's oldest social service ministries. It serves the needs of hurting people throughout the D.C. area: the homeless, families living in poverty, children from at-risk neighborhoods and the growing Hispanic population

3 FOUNDATION FOR PEACE is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to working hand-in-hand with people in materially impoverished areas of the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Kenya and Jamaica to provide educational support, healthcare access, economic opportunity, and hope.

4 HOLY LAND CHRISTIAN ECUMENICAL FOUNDATION is committed to the presence and well-being of Arab Christians in the West Bank and to developing the bonds of solidarity with Christians world-wide. It administers programs that create jobs, foster education, build and renovate homes, and offer support to Christians who desire to remain in the Holy Land.

5 COMMUNITY COUNCIL FOR THE HOMELESS/FRIENDSHIP PLACE, an NPC neighbor, provides a continuum of care to the homeless, including street outreach, case management, referrals, psychiatric care, medical care, benefits assistance, and transitional and permanent housing.

6 PEGGY McCRACKEN At the Christian Embassy, Peggy interacts with diplomats, wives of diplomats, and women who are chiefs of staff to members of Congress. Her purpose is to serve and to share with them the basic teachings of Jesus Christ.

7 HABITAT FOR HUMANITY D.C. believes that everyone deserves a home. It works to eliminate poverty housing and homelessness in the Nation's Capital by building affordable, energy- and resource-efficient homes for people in need.

8 OUR LADY QUEEN OF PEACE CHURCH (Regina Pacis) A Roman Catholic community of Palestinian Christians in the West Bank town of Birzeit, our partner church works to improve education, housing, and other material needs in its community, and

to offer the reconciling message of hope through Jesus Christ.

9 MARTHA'S TABLE, located in Northwest D.C., finds solutions to poverty in the short and long term. It addresses emergency needs with food and clothing programs, education, and family support services.

10 UNSUNG HEROES Led by Lance Carr and Madoda Nzima, Unsung Heroes is a ministry that seeks to awaken South Africa to the Gospel through a new dawn of outreach to those who live in poverty, are infected or affected by HIV/AIDS, or have become orphaned.

11 JOHN BERNBAUM NPC member John Bernbaum is President of the Russian-American Institute, which strengthens the Christian community through educational programs to be "salt and light" in the marketplace, to help build a just and peaceful society in the Russian Federation.

12 ESTHER WAKEMAN, PC(USA) missionary and VP for Spiritual and Community Life at Payap University, the oldest Christian college in Thailand, helps students through worship services, chapels, prayer groups, retreats, pastoral care, and a new residential life program.

13 PC(USA) MISSION IN THE MIDEAST As part of its mission work with the PC(USA), NPC supports a missionary couple (names withheld for security reasons) in a Middle Eastern country. This couple ministers to both local Christians and indigenous peoples there.

14 THIRD STREET CHURCH OF GOD is an African-American church in the heart of Washington, D.C. that reaches out to the Shaw community with Jesus' message of hope and healing.

15 FRASER AND LIZ BENNETT Translating the Bible for 200 million of the world's most marginalized people is a demanding task that requires extensive preparation and training. Fraser Bennett spearheads training for Wycliffe Bible Translators as its International Academic Training Coordinator.

16 SAN AWNG MAW (JUM) is a leader of minority tribes—both Christian and non-Christian—in Burma. Jum is furthering his education at Fuller Seminary, realizing that a Doctor of Ministry degree and stronger ties with the U.S. will strengthen his voice on behalf of the predominantly Christian Kachin people.

17 ONE MINISTRIES' UNIQUE LEARNING CENTER is a ministry to children in the Shaw community of Washington, D.C. Through its deliberate effort to shape and transform young lives in the name of Jesus, hope is evident and the future much brighter.

18 AFRICAN ENTERPRISE is committed to the transformation of Africa through the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It maintains ministries in ten African countries, focusing on evangelism, reconciliation, leadership training and community development.

19 MCGILVARY COLLEGE OF DIVINITY Under the leadership of Dean Satanun Boonyakiat, the college strives to develop leaders for Christian Ministry in churches, schools and hospitals in Thailand and the wider area of Southeast Asia.

20 BETHLEHEM BIBLE COLLEGE trains Christian servant-leaders for the churches and society within an Arab context. In addition to a traditional education, students are taught to become life-long learners, maintaining Christ-centeredness, godly humility, biblical wholeness, creative mercy, and justice in their jobs and ministries.

21 STUART AND CATHIE SHOWALTER work with Wycliffe Bible Translators to produce the Bible in the language of the Kaan people of Burkina Faso. This work has been underway since 1987 and is nearing completion.

22 KEITH PATMAN With Wycliffe Bible Translators, Keith provides tools and training to African Bible translators. He is developing Bible translation guides specifically for the French-speaking countries of Africa and is involved in twice-yearly training workshops in the Central African Republic.

23 CHISINAU SEMINARY, MOLDOVA educates national Christian leaders in theology, education, social services, and small business development for ministry throughout Central Asia and Eastern Europe.

24 NEW HOPE INTERNATIONAL builds ministry partnerships that mobilize churches to win the next generation for Christ in Eastern Europe. It empowers national teams in countries such as Moldova, Ukraine, Bulgaria, and Romania to share the Good News of Jesus with children, youth and families.

25 EVANGELICAL THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY Dr. Peter Kuzmic founded and directs the Evangelical Theological Seminary in Osijek, Croatia, the only evangelical graduate theological institution in Eastern Europe. Through the seminary, Dr. Kuzmic ministers to the physical and spiritual needs of his fellow citizens.

26 YOUNG LIFE/ JOHN WAGNER The goal of Young Life is to give young people hope for the future by sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ. John Wagner is Young Life's Senior Vice President for the Greater New York Division, a new position seeking to infuse one of the largest cities in the world with that same Good News.

27 DUSTIN AND SHERRI ELLINGTON are missionaries in Lusaka, Zambia, funded through PC(USA) World Mission. Dustin is a professor of New Testament at Justo Mwale Theological University College and Sherri teaches English. The University trains pastors and leaders, in English, for Presbyterian and other Reformed denominations in Africa.

28 MARY LOU LYON As a professional counselor, Mary Lou serves as a resource to pastors, missionaries, churches and mission agencies to provide emotional and spiritual care for their ministries in Eastern Europe.

29 MOLDOVA MARRIAGE MINISTRY is made up of an NPC team working with a leadership team in Moldova to help couples who are feeling the strains of economic hardship on their families. The ministry helps them reflect on their marriage and equips them with tools to strengthen their commitment to each other through the Lord.

30 BIRZEIT SENIOR DAY CARE CENTER provides nutritional, social, cultural, psychological, physical and medical support services to Seniors in Birzeit, West Bank. Difficult living conditions have driven many younger Christians to other countries to find employment and a better life, leaving the elderly alone and vulnerable.

31 THE PERSECUTED CHURCH Remember that every day Christians worldwide are imprisoned, tortured and martyred for their faith. Pray for those spreading the Gospel in treacherous situations.
