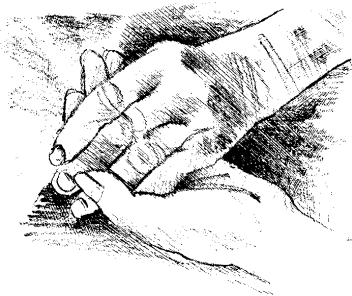

WHAT IS NPC IN TOUCH?

Once a month, a volunteer *In Touch Minister* visits a home-centered *congregant* to share a short devotional and some conversation with them.

WHAT DOES IT TAKE TO BE AN IN TOUCH MINISTER?

- A warm heart
- The time to visit once a month
- A desire to provide fellowship with, and be blessed by, members who can no longer regularly attend Sunday worship

WHO CAN BE AN IN TOUCH MINISTER?

- Individuals or Pairs
- Child with a parent
- Teens
- Couples
- College Age
- Older Adults

IS THIS MINISTRY FOR YOU?

Are you no longer able to regularly attend church due to physical challenges or illness?

Would you welcome a monthly visit with an NPC member who would come to your home to talk with you and share God's Word?

When getting out becomes so hard that you find it difficult to come to church, two things happen: You lose the fellowship and the blessing of the service; and the church loses the blessing of your fellowship.

Life's challenges can be difficult enough. When those challenges keep us from church services and the fellowship of other members, it makes coping with challenges even more difficult. This is the purpose of *NPC In Touch* — to bring spiritual encouragement to you in your own home. You may have contributed actively to the ministry of the church for years. This ministry can allow your blessing to others, and the church's blessing to you, to continue.

Congregants who enroll are partnered with an *In Touch Minister* for their fellowship and mutual benefit.
